# STOP

If you do not see 7 shades of color in the Figure 1 image below,  
You are not using the proper OVERPRINT VIEW in Your Version of Acrobat.  
If you do see the 7 shades please proceed to view your files.

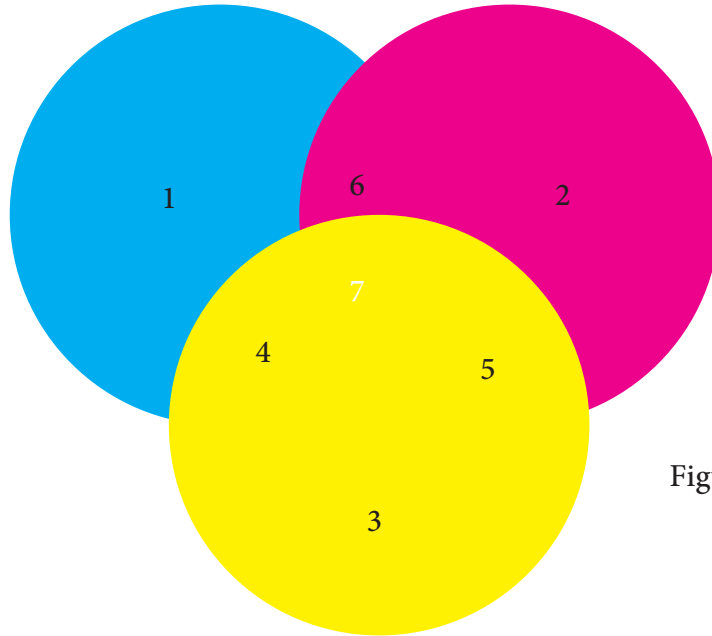

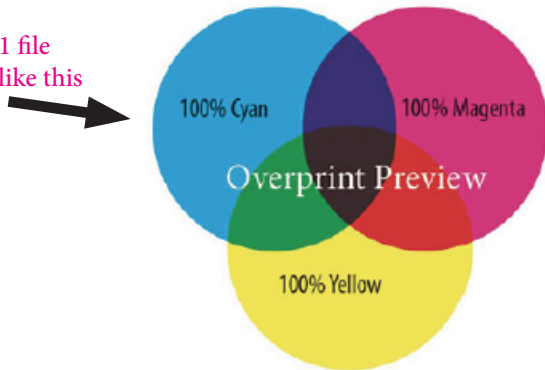
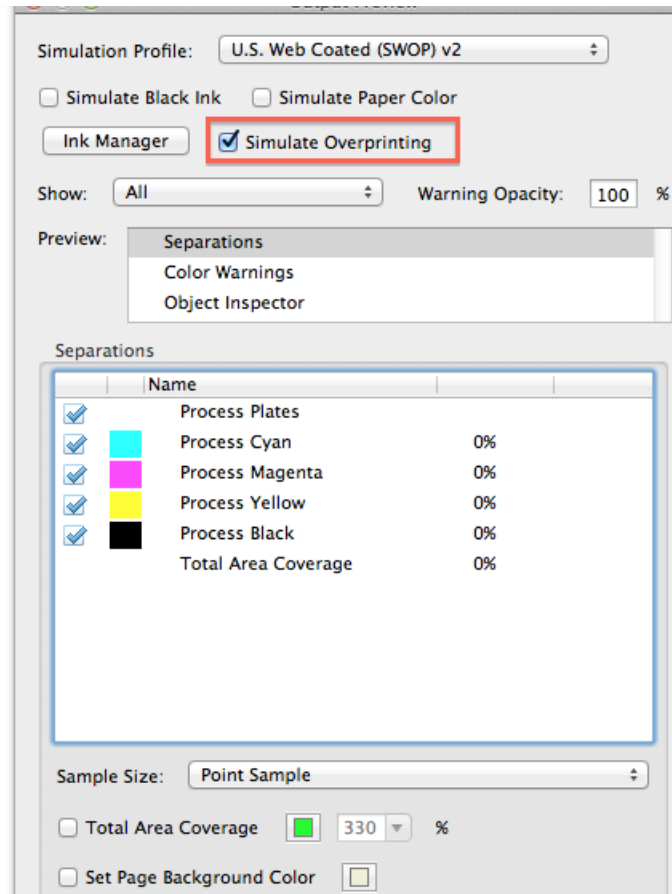
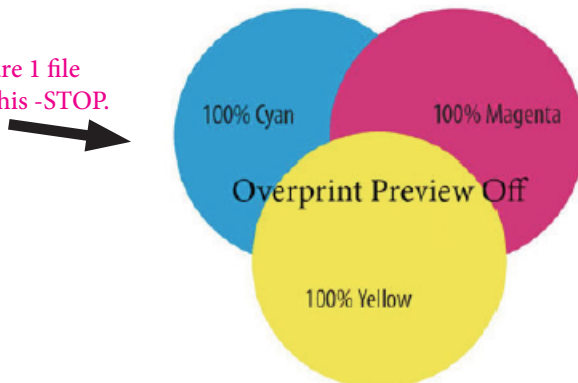


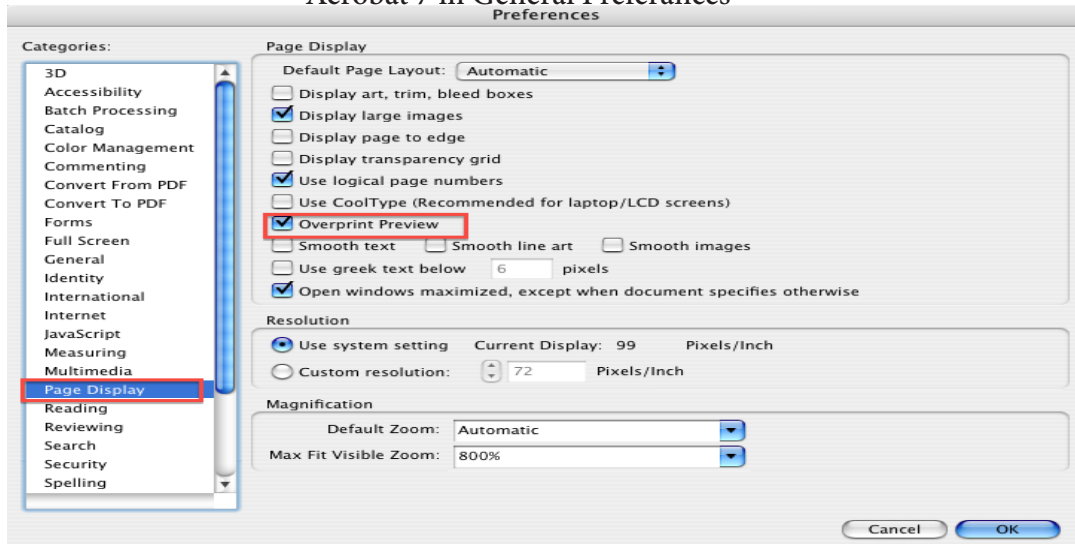
Figure 2 *Overprint turned on.*

If your Figure 1 image does not appear as the top image in Figure 2 below, the proceed to page 2.  
If page 2 does not resolve your view, then contact your Lake Book Mfg. Account Manager so they will  
be able to guide you to help turn your overprint preview on.

should look like this

Looks like look this -STOP.

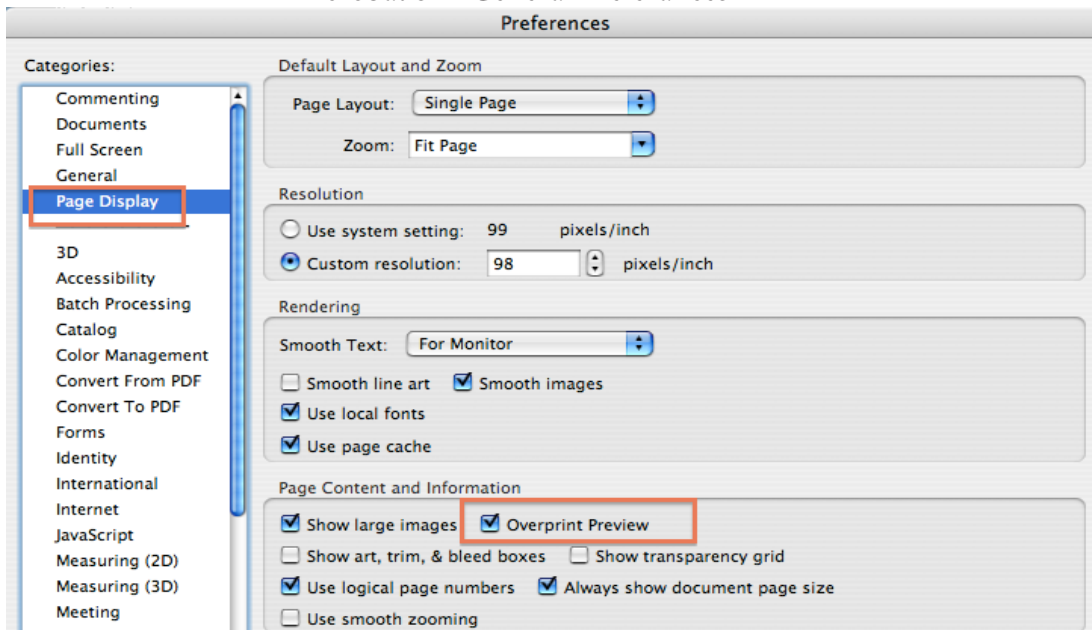
